

## AREA AND PRODUCTION OF MAJOR CROPS IN THE DISTRICT

In the state district Sangrur has largest area under Paddy cultivation. In wheat cultivation it occupies the second place in term of area and production . The district has also significant place in the area of some minor crops like gram, moong, cotton A and cotton D etc.
