Collection of Soil Samples from Kallar Soils

i. Dig a pit of 3 meter depth in Kallar affected soils and Mark the depth as 6", 1' and 2' as shown in *Table-4.* Accordingly collect 4 samples of ½ Kg. soil from each depth. Put each sample in clean dry cloth bag and should be properly marked to identify the sample(Name of the farmer, village, Name of the field, depth of the sample). If the soil is wet, then dry it in shade before packing. Soil sample information sheet should be prepared for each sample. This sheet may be sent separately to the laboratory or enclosed with the soil sample.

- ii. Send the soil samples to the nearest Soil Testing Laboratory.
- iii. Keep a record of the Soil samples along with area sampled and a simple sketch/map for reference.

Note: Soil samples may be taken with the help of AUGER.
