

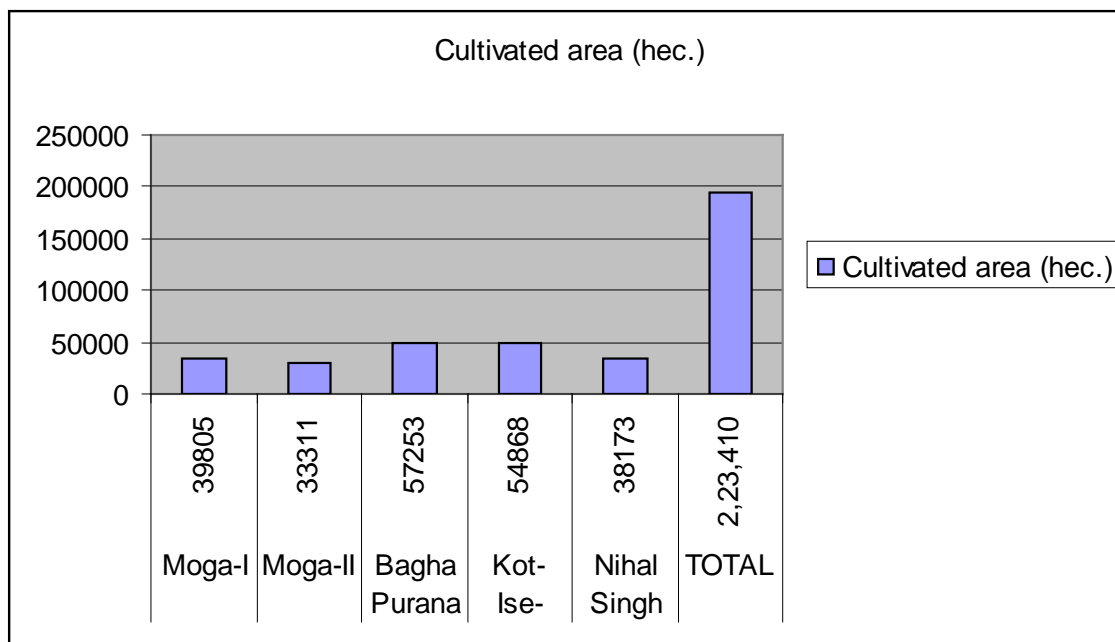
DISTRICT AT GALANCE AND DEMOGRAPHIC PROFILE

2.2.2 Demographic Profile

Demographic profile of the district is presented in the table. Moga has a total population of 8,94,854 which is 3.65 percent of the total state population consisting of 4,74,139 males and 4,20,705 females which is 68 percent and 58 percent respectively. Although rate of population growth is low but the density of population has increased, which is 400 per sq.km. as compared to 351 by 1991 census. In the district 63.40 percent is literate. The total population of SC are 2,50,162. The total literate population is 3,82,271. There are 330 villages in the district, out of which 325 villages are inhabited and 5 are uninhabited. The total rural population is almost 80 percent whereas urban population is about 20 percent.
