

Existing Schemes and resources

S.No.	Scheme	Remarks
1	Soil Testing & land reclamation	Soil and water samples are tested in the soil testing labs. On the test basis fertility maps, are prepared and land reclamation is done as per recommendation.
2	Extension and Training	Under this scheme, farmer training camps have been organized at district , block and village level.Latest research activities have also been disseminated through printed leaflets.
3	Crop Diversification	Seed mini kits of different crops are distributed to the farmers free of cost to popularize crops of less importance.
4	HYVP	To ensure quality supply of certified seed and uniform distribution of seed through Govt. and Pvt. Seed producing agencies.
5	Pulses and Oil seed	To promote production of oilseeds & pulses & to popularize new varieties, seed minikits are distributed free of cost to the farmers & trainings are held time to time as required.
6	Cotton extension Programme	To ensure timely and quality supply of B.T.cotton seed and other cotton varietiesThe farmers training camps have been organized and seed treatment demonstration's are organized.
7	Plant Protection	Regular surveillance of incidence of insect, pest and diseases have been conducted and farmers are guided on the basis of surveillance. Quality supply of insecticide have also been ensured.
8	Locust control and Plant Protection	Insecticides are supplied by the Govt. to control locust and farmers have been advised about the specific pest likely to enter in the state and measures to check its movement.
9	Canal Command development programme	Five blocks namely Ferozepur, Mamdot, Guru Har Sahai, Jalalabad, and Fazilka have been covered under this scheme to demonstrate efficient use of irrigation water, water saving practices and to promote crops requiring less water.
10	Sir Ratan Tata Trust scheme (IPM)	To create awareness among farmers regarding identification of insect-pest and natural enemies and to conduct surveillance to ensure need based sprays.
11	Inputs	To ensure timely & quality supply of farm inputs & regular distribution of fertilizers.
12	Seed production	Govt. seed farm at Salem Shah consists 22 acres of cultivated land & during last year infrastructure have been strengthened for seed production programme.
13	Agriculture	ATMA is an autonomous institution with participation of
