

General description of the districts

Mansa district was declared on 13th April 1992 from the rest while district of Bathinda. It lies between 29.58' to 36.33" in North & 75.23' to 34.87" East at the elevation of 716 Feet from sea level. Mansa is a small district both in terms of population and area. It is situated between Bathinda-Jind-Delhi rail line and also on Barnala-Sardulgarh-Sirsa Road. This district surrounded by Bathinda district in North West, by Sangrur District in east and by Sirsa District of Harayana State in the south. The District Consists three Sub Divisions i.e. Mansa, Budhlada and Sardulgarh and 5 blocks i.e. Mansa, Budhlada, Bhikhi, Jhunir, Sardulgarh. The District has 243 villages, 5 Market committees, 5 Nagar councils and 246 Gramm Panchyats with geographical area 216000 ha. Mansa is the head district quarters. Map of Mansa is shown in figure 2.1
