LAND USE PATTERN & LAND HOLDING

The size of operational holdings in this district is generally very small. Small holdings coupled with varying topography are the limiting factors in introduction of mechanized farming. With less than 10% of holdings falling in the size group of 10 ha & above, a strategy wherein technological interventions feasible in small holdings are to be planned for higher and sustainable growth of agriculture.





Fig. III Land Use Classification of District
