Terms and Conditions: -

1. Chairperson and the official members of the State Council shall be appointed for a period of the five years .
2. The period of the newly appointed non-official members (from S. No. 7 to S.No. 15 of the above list) will be five years.
3. The meeting of the Council will be held at Chandigarh or at any place to be decided by the Council.

Quorum: - The quorum of the member for the meeting shall be 1/3rd of the total number.

Duties and Function of the State Council:-

- a) Advising the State Government on all matters concerning the Scheme and
- b) Reviewing the monitoring and redressal mechanisms form time to time and recommending improvements.
- c) Promoting the widest possible dissemination of information about National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (NREGA), 2005.
- d) Monitoring the implementation of National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (NREGA), 2005 and the Schemes in the State and coordinating such implementation with the Central Council.
- e) Preparing the annual report to be laid before the State Legislative by the State Government.

- f) Any other duty or function as may be assigned to it by the Central Council or the State Government.

The State Council shall have the power to undertake an evaluation of the schemes operating in the State for that purpose to collect or cause to be collected statistics pertaining to the rural economy and the implementation of the Schemes and programmes in the State.
